The exhibitions of Viljandi Museum were in four buildings – in the exhibition hall of the museum, in the Old Water Tower, in Mart Saar Museum and the Kondas Centre. All in all, 19 377 people visited the exhibitions, including 5989 in the exhibition hall.

The total number of visitors and researchers using the library reading room was 1762.

Museum-pedagogical events and lectures were organised on 121 occasions for 2436 people.
